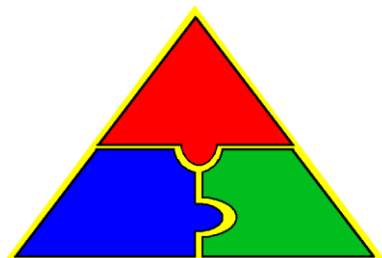

By regularly reviewing the number of school places in Wrexham, the authority can address any forecast changes in demand and respond to rapid changes in demographics. This ensures that there are enough school places, of the right type, in the right location.
