

# BE ALERT

I received an e mail late yesterday informing me of two incidents of potential child abduction near schools in the Weston Rhyn and Oswestry area during the last few days. Both incidents have occurred around opening and closure times and involved a black van. We have spoken to the children today in assembly, reminding them of stranger danger with the holidays approaching but have not discussed any specific threat. All staff are aware of the recent incidents and will be extra vigilant when letting the children out. As parents, you are all very good at reporting any concerns to members of staff and we appreciate your help in ensuring the safety of children coming in and out of school.
